

# ARCTIC ICE ARENA 2011 SPRING ICE SHOW "Arctic's Legends of Music"

## DEAR PARENTS:

ICE SHOW TIME IS UPON US! Once again, we will be skating and rehearsing in the Championship Rink. *(Please refer to Ticket Information paragraph!)* Any skaters enrolled the 2011 Winter Session of learn-to-skate are invited to skate in the Arctic Ice Arena's 2011 Spring Ice Show "Arctic's Legends of Music". **WE ENCOURAGE ALL AGES AND LEVELS TO PARTICIPATE – FROM GIRLS TO BOYS TO ADULTS! THIS SHOW HAS SOMETHING FOR EVERYONE!** Each group number is scheduled for six rehearsals, a dress rehearsal and three performances. Rehearsals are 40 minutes and are conveniently scheduled during times when classes would normally be in session. The dress rehearsal is scheduled for Thursday, June 2, 2011 at 5:00 pm and should be approximately 2-1/2 hours long if everything runs smoothly. The show performances are Friday evening at 7:00 pm and Saturday at 2:00 pm and 7:00 pm. The show will run approximately 2-1/2 hours excluding a brief 15 minute intermission. Please bring your friends and family to see and enjoy the skating talents of all of our students.

## WHAT IS THE COMMITMENT?

Ice show participation requires a commitment of time, money and support from the entire family.

## REGISTRATION & COSTUME FORM

To participate in the 2011 Spring Ice Show, all skaters must enroll in the 2011 Winter Session of the Learn-to-Skate program. You must be registered for your Learn-to Skate class at the time of ice show registration. You can register for the ice show during the month of February 2011. **The deadline for ice show registration will be Monday, March 7, 2011 at Noon.** The form must include the costume sizing per the sizing chart and be accompanied by full payment of \$100. DO NOT TURN IN REGISTRATION FORMS WITHOUT CURRENT LEVEL OR COSTUME SIZE. This will hold up the costume ordering and grouping process. The ice show fee covers costs such as lighting, choreography, set design, costume, etc. The 2011 Ice Show registration fee is absolutely non-refundable.

## GROUP ASSIGNMENTS

Groups will be assigned by the Ice Show Director and instructors based on skating ability. Every effort will be made to place the skater in the appropriate level, however, a skater might be moved up or down one level depending on the number of participants in a group. Costumes and final groups will not be revealed until after costumes have been ordered. All ice show registration forms must be signed by the skater's group class instructor to ensure the levels being registered for are correct. While costumes and music may be displayed on the bulletin board, it is the Skating Director's right to change any costume or music at the time of costume ordering due to unavailability of costume, number of skaters registered for groups, etc. Groups/Music/Costumes will be posted on the bulletin board in either the rink or lobby in Mid-March 2011.

## ABOUT REHEARSALS

It is only with consistent participation during rehearsals that a good performance can happen so attendance is mandatory. We have tried our best to make rehearsal times convenient but also understand that illness or scheduling conflicts can occur. If your skater will be tardy or absent from a rehearsal, we ask that a phone call explaining the reason be made to Charice Herschbach at (708) 403-4231 Ext. 121 prior to that rehearsal.

PLEASE BE ADVISED:

- If a skater has missed more than one rehearsal we reserve the right to withdraw that skater from the ice show.
- The registration fee is **ABSOLUTELY NON-REFUNDABLE!**

Skaters are to arrive early enough to get skates on and be on the ice at the beginning of their scheduled time. Latecomers make it very difficult for the instructor/choreographer. This is unfair to the rest of the group and wastes valuable ice time. Skaters should also wear clothing appropriate for skating (no jeans please).

## REHEARSAL SCHEDULES

Please see the attached calendar for rehearsal schedule. **The first rehearsal for all groups is MANDATORY.** PLEASE BE PROMPT! ***Outside food may not be brought into the rink during rehearsals.*** You may purchase dinner at Bubba's Bistro or The Original Six Bar & Grill above the Championship Rink. Only parents who purchase food from The Original Six Bar & Grill may view rehearsals from the restaurant. Menus will be available at the check-in table. Please keep in mind that parents will be prohibited from entering the Championship Rink during rehearsals.

## COSTUMES

Costumes should arrive at the Ice Arena around mid-May 2011 if ordered in a timely manner. Costumes will be distributed during Rehearsal #5. Try on your costumes immediately when you receive them. Remember we are unable to return costumes – if you need to trade or alterations need to be made they are the responsibility of the parent. Also, put the skater's name in or on the costume immediately so there are no mix-ups.

## PHOTOS/VIDEOTAPING

Pictures will be taken with exact day & time to be posted later. A professional video production company will also be available to take orders for DVD's and VHS cassettes of the ice show. ***No videotaping will be allowed during the ice show.***

## DRESS REHEARSAL

Dress rehearsal is Thursday, June 2, 2011 and is a very important part of show preparation. Prompt arrival and complete cooperation is much appreciated. **ALL SKATERS SHOULD ARRIVE IN SKATES AND FULL COSTUME.** Because specified arrival times allow for preparation and organization, please understand that you/your child may not be skating immediately. This is also an opportunity for the skaters and parents to watch the show for free. Tickets should be purchased in advance due to limited seating. The only time you will be permitted to enter the ice arena without a ticket is if you are a volunteer or performer.

Please note: Children will not be released to anyone other than a parent unless previously authorized to do so.

## PERFORMANCES

Performances will be at 7:00 pm on Friday and 2:00 and 7:00 pm on Saturday. Specific arrival times for group numbers will be available the final week of rehearsals.

## LOCKER ROOM RULES AND ASSIGNMENTS

Skaters are to check in with the monitor at the time of arrival. Please be prompt. The show will not wait for ANY skater. Only active volunteers functioning as monitors are allowed in the Locker/Meeting Rooms. Dads/Males are not allowed in the Girls Locker Rooms. Dads may assist their sons in a designated Boys Dressing Area. Skaters should refrain from bringing valuables (jewelry, CD players, I-pods) in to the Locker room. Arctic Ice Arena is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Cell phones, still and video cameras are not to be used in the locker rooms. Skaters should eat a satisfactory meal before arriving at the ice arena for the dress rehearsal and show performances. NO FOOD OR BEVERAGE (other than water) is allowed in the Locker/Meeting Rooms.

### ***PURCHASE TICKETS EARLY! THERE IS A LIMITED AMOUNT OF SEATING!***

Tickets are required for everyone, with the exception of performers and volunteers. Children ages 2 and under do not need a ticket. Performers, parents and siblings will be allowed to watch the Dress Rehearsal for free. Tickets go on sale May 2<sup>nd</sup> at 9:00 am. Doors will open 30 minutes before show time.

## DINNER PACKAGE INFORMATION

The Original Six Bar & Grill will once again have dinner packages available. With the wonderful view from the windows and the awesome sound system, this ice show will be a one-of-a-kind experience. The dining area will be open to Dinner Package ticket holders only. Dinner Packages are limited to window tables so don't miss out! ### TIGHTS AND BOOT COVERS

Ice Show participants may be required to provide minor costume accessories such as tights and boot covers. These items will be available for purchase at the Pro Shop in the Ice Arena lobby.

### HAIR AND MAKE-UP

Make-up is optional for the 2011 Spring Ice Show. Application of tasteful and appropriate make-up is at the discretion of the individual skater and parents and should be applied before leaving for the Ice Arena. Hair should be neatly arranged for costume accent. Bobby pins, unless securely fastened should not be used. Even the smallest of stray material can prove to be unsafe to the skaters.

### PROGRAM BOOKS

Commemorative program books will be on sale for \$5 before and during the performances.

### SPECIAL WISHES

Don't forget to wish that special skater good luck in their performance with a 2009 Spring Ice Show Program Book Special Wish! Fun Blocks begin at \$5 and can be purchased until April 30th. Forms will be available at the Front Desk from April 15<sup>th</sup> through April 30<sup>th</sup> and must be returned no later than May 8, 2011.

### FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Again, as changes or additions to the Ice Show Information Packet become necessary, they will be posted on the Bulletin Board in the Lobby and/or check-in desk so check often!

# COSTUME SIZING INFORMATION

When measuring and sizing, please remember a few key factors:

If your child is still growing, keep this in mind. It will be another three months before your child will be wearing the costume.

It is much easier to alter a costume that is too big than to try to fix a costume that is too small.

We CANNOT return costumes for a different size. It takes between 10-12 weeks to receive the costumes once ordered.

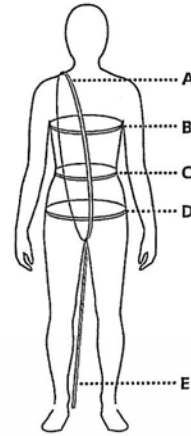
The guide on the size chart will help show you how to do the measuring. Using the Sizing Chart, match your measurements to the size you feel would be most appropriate. This sizing chart is from the catalog in which we order our costumes.

### Determining Your Size

For the most accurate fit, use a measuring tape and have someone help you measure following the instructions as noted. Remember: a leotard, swimsuit or undergarments are worn when taking measurements, not street clothes. Then find the measurements on the size charts to determine the appropriate size. It is our experience that when the chest and hip measurements do not correspond with a particular size, the girth measurement should be used as the deciding factor.



- A) GIRTH: Measure from the center of one shoulder, down the front through crotch and up the back to starting point.
- B) BUST/CHEST: With arms relaxed down at sides, measure around the fullest part of chest, keeping tape measure parallel to the floor.
- C) WAIST: Measure around natural waistline, the narrowest part of the upper body (not over shirt or pants).
- D) HIPS: Measure around fullest part of the lower body, keeping tape straight and parallel to the floor.
- E) INSEAM: Measure inside of leg, from the crotch to 2 inches below the ankle bone.
